But wait...Rosh Hashanah doesn't begin until October 2, so why are we discussing this in February?

Because after forty years, the Reform Movement has created a brand new, beautifully written, inspiring, and contemporary High Holy Day *Machzor* (prayer book), *Mishkan HaNefesh* (*Tabernacle of the Soul*). It is a two volume set, one for Rosh Hashanah and one for Yom Kippur. We are delighted to introduce this new edition to CRJ for a deeper and more accessible prayer experience during the Days of Awe.

As has always been the custom at the Congregation of Reform Judaism, each congregant owns their own copy of the prayer book. So we are asking you, for only the second time in 40 years, to purchase the prayer book. As in the past, we will have a limited number of books at the synagogue, but they will only be available to guests.

An additional benefit to owning your personal copies of *Mishkan HaNefesh* is the year round opportunity to reflect on the themes and ideas of the High Holy Days. This is sure to enhance the experience in the synagogue when those important days arrive.

As a member congregation of the Union for Reform Judaism we are able to purchase the set of books at a discounted rate of \$45 for both volumes. **As a special incentive, if you purchase the books before May 1st, Rabbi Engel will be happy to write a personal note to you in your prayer book.**
